

3064 - Audience Summary

Course 3064 v2 is designed for students who have limited knowledge of the Linux Operating System with the knowledge and skill to perform fundamental administration tasks using SUSE Linux Enterprise Server 10. Course 3064 v2 also prepares a student for CompTIA's Linux+ exam. This course can also be used in place of Novell's SUSE Linux Enterprise Server 10 Fundamentals (Course 3071 v2) to prepare for the Novell Certified Linux Professional 10 (CLP 10) certification.

3064 - Course Prerequisites

This course is designed for beginners with the Linux Operating System. Attendees are required to have only basic computer skills on any operating system. Knowledge of a Desktop Operating System is sufficient.
